**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE USE OF 2011-2012 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FOR WATER PLANT REPAIRS.**

**WHEREAS, the City of Highland Park has been approved for \$233,000 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Funds; and**

**WHEREAS, the City has not yet determined how it would allocate those funds for use in the city; and**

**WHEREAS, CDBG funds can be used for public facility improvement, and the city is in dire need of making improvements to its water plant, a public facility;**

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council agrees to allocate up to \$150,000 of the 2011-2012 Community Development Block Grant in the category of public facility improvement to be spent on facility improvements to the water plant; and**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City Council authorizes the administration through Community and Economic Development and HUD to take the necessary steps to make available the proposed funds in order to address issues and repairs at the water plant as soon as possible consistent with federal guidelines and requirements. 
