ENHANCED METER ACCURACY

The Highland Park Water Department is stepping up efforts to ensure accurate water meter readings amid billing audits, leak detection, and prep for new GLWA water master meters. Some commercial and residential meters have shown zero usage despite active service, creating billing issues that affect all ratepayers.

If your bill shows zero consumption but you're using water, your service could be at risk. Residents who've received meter inspection notices must schedule appointments immediately to avoid disconnection. For questions or to schedule, contact the Water Department.
