CONSUMER CONFIDENCE REPORT (CCR)

This is the annual report about your drinking water quality. Throughout the report, we explain where your water comes from, the results of the sampling we performed, and our efforts to protect your water.



WATER MASTER METER PROJECT

Construction and installation of three (3) water master meters and vaults at designated connection points (HP-05, HP-06, and HP-07) between the City and Great Lakes Water Authority (GLWA).

- Locations:
 - HP-05: Hamilton Avenue & McNichols Road
 - HP-06: John R. Street & McNichols Road
 - HP-07: Hamilton Avenue & Webb Street

WATER MAIN AND LEAD SERVICE LINE REPLACEMENT

- Phase One: The replacement of 2.49 miles of water main and 138 lead service lines on John R. Street and Brush Street from Davison Freeway to Tennyson Street, Tennyson Street from Woodward Avenue to Oakland Avenue, and Oakland Park Boulevard.
- Phase Two: Hamilton Avenue from McNichols Road to Oakman Boulevard consists of approximately 1.00 miles of water main replacement.
